I love the article that Kathie Walters wrote, *Angels Are Into Weight-Lifting*. You can read it on the Elijah List. She wrote—*Did you know that angels are into "weight lifting"? They hate the weights that weigh you down. When there are weights on you, you can't get into the spirit realm. (Let this truth sink deep into your spirit, so you are aware and can throw off the weights) So, the enemy loves to burden you down with religious mindsets that make you work at it, and strive, and try – try to do what Jesus has already done. Trying can be very trying.*

God doesn't want you to work for him," He wants you to yield to Him so that he can work through you. He doesn't need you to try and meet every need that you see. I like that Kathie goes on to tell us that we should *sit down, take a break, enjoy the Lord, after all, that is your first calling, isn’t it?* And I say, a most emphatic YES! YES! YES!

I received my first vision shortly after I became a Christian. It was the introduction into the deliverance ministry, and since that night back in 1960, I have had many angelic vision encounters. Saints, God knows exactly what you need and He will supply it. We do not have to strive to be used in the Kingdom of God; just be yourself, seek His face, spend precious quality time in His holy presence and let Him bring you into His anointing. I am so thankful that I don’t have to qualify, measure up, strive to become, or etc. God only asks that I sit in His presence and listen—receive—trust—and then obey.

It is what Jesus did. It really is that simple. Why do we have such a tendency to make it hard? The Word of God tells us it is because of the enemy of our soul, and his tactics that come against us. Be aware of Satan’s tactics, his ploys, his plans of destruction and avoid them; we can you know, as we yield to the Holy Spirit. He will lead us into victory.
